

## MUSK THISTLE



**Control Methods:** Shovel – cut the root an inch below the soil surface. If in flower, bag the heads and put them in the trash. Best to get in rosette stage. Can spray with 2,4-D or Weed-B-Gone.

## Houndstongue



**Control Methods:** Shovel – cut the root an inch below the soil surface. If in flower, bag the heads and put them in the trash. Best to get in rosette stage. Can spray with 2,4-D or Weed-B-Gone.



## Canada Thistle



**Control Methods:** Has a massive root system. Best to spray with 2,4-D or Weed-B-Gone. Can mow or pull, but have to do it before flowering and then repeat every 10-14 days.
